The Junior Tennis Academy reflects values of Positivity, Effort, Coachability, Independence, & Respect. Its aim is to foster the development of a player's technical and tactical skill, as well as their character. Group placement is based on age, height, size, but most importantly general athletic and tennis ability.

Toddler Tennis (Walking 18months – 2.5 years) – Mini Tennis Ages 2.5y – 3.5y – Little Tennis Ages 3.5y – 5y

A child's first experience in an active group setting. The class consists of a variety of activities, and its aim is to help foster and nurture athletic skills, movement, coordination, and safety for any sport - especially tennis. This class is a parent-accompanied program. For ages 18mo-3.5 years (both TT & MT), a parent must be present and actively participating with their child. For ages 4-5, a parent should remain nearby to actively assist as needed. A minimum of four players are needed to hold the class. Parents tell your friends! Parents and players should be dressed for active movement. Our combo classes are perfect for siblings The first 30mins of the combo class, will be all ages combined. At 30mins there will be a short water break, then the last 30mins of the class will only be for older Little Tennis players ages 3.5 - 5y. Bring a snack for your younger ones!

Red Ball 1 Ages 5-7 & Red Ball 2 Ages 6-7

Players must be 5 years old and in kindergarten to register for Group A and above. Most children will experience tennis for the first time on the mini court. This is a fun, playful, and active introduction to tennis. In Red 1, children develop basic racket & ball skills, along with establishing strong athletic movement & coordination. After graduating from Red 1, players in Red 2, continue to develop all the above basic skills but will also work with a partner and coaches attempting to build a short rally.

Advanced Red Ball Ages 7-8

Red ball players continue to play on mini courts and with mini nets. Rallying and competing with classmates brings great energy to this class. Players continue improving basic skills while learning to keep score and perfect longer rallies.

Orange Ball Ages 8-10

For beginners ages 8-10, or younger players who've graduated from Red Ball. Players begin the transition to a traditional net on 60' court, with orange ball. More emphasis will be placed on technique, tactics, and smoothing and perfecting proper form for all strokes.

Green Ball Ages 8-10

For players who have graduated from Orange Ball. Green ball players are making the transition to a full-size court. Coaches begin to sharpen technique and tactics. Players are encouraged to compete in local tournaments.

Advanced Green Ball Ages 8-10 *Staff Approval is Required*

Registration & Payment - PLEASE READ

GHC-Tri-State is moving towards a new registration process, where most all registrations should be completed using the GHC online portal, which is accessible to all members and non-members who have a profile within our computer system. The portal is accessible on desktops and smart phones, and although an app is not yet available, the portal can be saved like an app on the home screen of smart phones.

- **Do not allow the registration process to be a hinderance to play.** This is a new process. Please read the instructions below, and if you have any issues, still bring your child to class regardless. If help is needed to access the online portal, please contact the front desk 812-479-3111. After accessing the portal- contact the tennis department ext. 219, for issues with registration.
- Parents should be sure and sign beginners up for the age-appropriate group. Please read the descriptions on the first page.
 A student who does not meet the skill level requirements will be moved to a compatible class. Genesis does not issue refunds.

Members & Returning Non-members do need to access their GHC online portal to register their player.

- When using the portal, whether on a desktop or phone, be sure and hit the drop-down button in the top right-hand corner and select your player's name under secondaries. This will ensure that parents and guardians register each individual player and not a parent, by accident.
- Members wanting the member-only sibling discount, should be sure that the discount shows on the balance of the portal before they complete the registration on the portal.

- Genesis does not issue refunds
 - For medical disabilities, players will be allowed to make-up their remaining classes in a future session.
 - A player who does not meet the skill level requirements will be moved to a compatible class
 - If any class is cancelled, Tri-State shall make every effort to reschedule the class, or the player can make-up another day.
- 3. There is a minimum and maximum enrollment for each class. Make every effort to register early if possible.
- 4. A player is allowed to make-up two classes per 8-week session.
