Group placement is based on age, height, size, but most importantly general athletic and tennis ability.

Toddler Tennis & Little Tennis (Formally Court Kids) Ages 2-3 (TT) • Ages 3-5 (LT)// Mini Court & Red ball play Your child's first experience on a tennis court. This is usually a parent-accompanied program. The class consists of a variety of activities, and its aim is to help foster and nurture the athletic skills, movement, coordination, and safety for any sport - especially tennis. For 2-3 year-olds, a parent must be present and be actively involved. For ages 4-5, a parent should remain nearby to actively assist as needed. Minimum of four players needed to hold the class.

 - For medical disabilities, a pro-rated refund/credit shall be given from the date the refund is requested when accompanied by a doctor's statement explaining the nature of the disability or injury and duration.
 - A participant shall be given a pro-rated refund/credit should a class be cancelled after the start of the session.
 - A student who does not meet the skill level requirements will be asked to change to a compatible class or will be issued a pro-rated refund or credit.
 - If any class is cancelled, Tri-State shall make every effort to reschedule the class. If the class cannot be
 rescheduled, each participant shall be given a refund or credit for the cancelled class.
 If a participant cannot attend the rescheduled class, that student shall be given a credit or refund for the class.
 - Only the Director of Tennis may approve lesson refunds, credits, or pro-rated fees.
- There is a minimum and maximum enrollment for each class. A player is allowed to make-up two classes per 8-week session.
 To request a make-up class contact the program coordinator within the Tennis Department.
 Make-up classes do not carry over to the next session.
